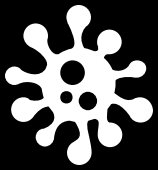
I do not have a return date/I do not have a medical provider.

In order for your child's absences to be excused, we must have a return date for your child. You need to contact a medical provider or the City of Lubbock Health Department to get a return date for your child. Once you contact us with the return date, your child will be excused absent through that date.

- If parent requests testing from the school, refer them to nurse.

You will need to contact your healthcare provider to obtain a return date; or, would you like to speak with our nurse?

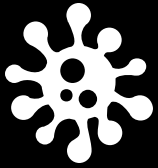

What are your COVID-19 protocols for the school year?

- WE FOLLOW GOVERNOR'S ORDERS.
